

Danville Council Work Study

February 6, 2017 ~ 6:00pm

Council President Marcia Lynch called the work study to order at 6:00pm on February 6, 2017 at Town Hall, 49 N Wayne Street. Members present were Jim Stephens, Mike Neilson, Marcia Lynch, Tom Pado, and Dennis Wynn. Also present were, Gary Eakin, Laura Parker, Jenny Pearcy, Chief Raney, Supt. Will Lacey, Supt. Jim Russell and Supt. Jerry Crisp.

Public Meeting

A. *Danville Wastewater* – Growth & future service areas, increased compliance & rates. Superintendent Jerry Crisp, Pretreatment Coordinator Darren Collier, Town Manager Gary Eakin and Buzz Krohn with OWK & Associates presented to the council the master plan and future of wastewater.

Also at the work study, Manager Andy Esser, Engineer Matt Rechtin and CEO Brad Eisenhart representing the town biggest industrial client Twin Bridges Land Fill the Town has a sewer service agreement with which uses most of industrial waste capacity, at this time leaving only 10% for future industrial waste. Kent Elliott representing Banning Engineering brought his input to the table.

Jerry also talked about residential lateral repairs, could the town split the cost for repairs, older lateral inspections, etc.

Buzz Krohn with OWK & Associates' presented to the council utility rate comparison information of other Towns & Cities. In the 3- 5 years raising sewer rates will help with the cost of upgrades/expansions of the wastewater plant/sewer mains with the growth of the town. The last rate increase was in 2011. Buzz also talked about the water bonds and refinancing them to get a better rate which keeps the water rate from going up.


The council will come back on a later date for more discussion.


President Marcia Lynch adjourned the meeting at 7:00 pm.
