
Public Meeting

- A. **Smithville Communications** – John Patten with Smithville updated the Council with their new marketing approach. Progress has been slow. John Pattern who represents Smithville shared with the council their marketing presentations on getting new customers that live in town to connect to the town's fiber for internet services. Smithville maintains this service and is willing to allow the Town of Danville out of the contract to allow another internet service to give it a try.
- B. **Internal Control Policy**- Clerk Treasurer Jenny Percy informed the Council regarding the State Board of Accounts and the state mandate that all employees must watch the Internal Controls training video. It is meant to curtail theft and fraud. All town employees must watch the video. A few department heads and the Council watched the video.
- C. **Health Clinics**- Clerk-Treasurer Jenny Percy sits on the IACT Medical Trust Board. The IACT Medical Trust will be offering grants to assist in establishing a Health clinic in three communities. This will be a pilot program in 2017. This will help lower cost for town employees and their families for healthcare coverage. The town could partner with the county or school to offer a clinic for our employees. The council agreed to move forward and submit the application to IACT and talk to Dr. Shafer about partnering with the Danville School Corporation. President Lynch will talk with Hendricks Regional Health who currently provides the clinic for Danville Schools and Hendricks County employees.


