


*Danville Town Council Meeting Minutes*


April 28, 2017

- I. **Call to Order:** Council President, Marcia Lynch, called the meeting of the Danville Town Council to order at 5:00 pm on April 28, 2017 in the Danville Town Hall, 49 N. Wayne Street.
- II. **Roll Call:** President, Marcia Lynch acknowledged a quorum of the Council and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag. Clerk-Treasurer noted the following Council members in attendance: Jim Stephens, Mike Neilson, Marcia Lynch, Tom Pado and Dennis Wynn. The following Administrative officials were present: Gary Eakin, Town Manager, Laura Parker, Assistant Town Manager and Jenny Pearcy, Clerk Treasurer.
- III. **Public Meeting:**
  - a) **Ordinance to Establish an Underground and Buried Utility District** – Gary Eakin the Town Manager explained to the council the importance of the meeting. The state is looking at passing a bill allowing utilities to place fifty foot poles in the right-a-ways with a cell router on the top of these poles. These poles can be placed anywhere in the right-a- way without the any approval from towns and cities. By establishing this Ordinance 9-2017 as a public necessity, health and safety now require that all utilities located within the Town's ROW shall be placed underground. Motion was made to suspend the rules by Jim Stephens and seconded by Mike Neilson. Motion passed 5-0.  
  
Motion was made by Mike Neilson to approve and adopt Ordinance 9 – 2017; seconded by Dennis Wynn. Motion passed 5-0.
- IV. **Public Comment** – No public comment.
- V. **Adjourn** – President Marcia Lynch adjourned the meeting at approximately 5.25 p.m.
