July 24, 2017 ~ 6:00pm



Public Meeting


The East Main St. Corridor has been somewhat neglected, and needs to be looked at for redevelopment. In order to drive public and private reinvestment, the Town needs to develop a strategic plan to demonstrate its commitment to move this area forward. Tim Jensen President of Veridus Group, which provides redevelopment consulting services for towns and cities and Courtney Zaugg employed by Veridus Group, would work with the town by gathering data by setting up Framing Sessions, Focus Groups and Document Reviews at the cost of \$29,450.00. A committee of 8-12 mostly Danville residents would be made up to discuss the incoming information & data that Veridus Group collects bringing ideas and input for the needs of redevelopment of East Main St. Matt Browning with Brownsburg Economic Redevelopment Commission who represents Hendricks Regional Hospital and Jamie Boller Smith with Hendricks County Tourism are interested and being part of the redevelopment. The council will come back with their decision August 7th 2017.
