RE: Open House for Stratford Way Reconstruction

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you have likely heard, Stratford Way within Stratford Ridge Subdivision is getting reconstructed. The project entails tearing out nearly 1000 feet of pavement, installing a drainage system and placing stone and pavement back. This will be a significant inconvenience for yourself and your neighbors.

The Town of Danville would like to give you the opportunity to come to an open house to see the construction plans, view the temporary traffic pattern during construction and ask questions of design professionals. This will be an informal meeting for the exchange of information. There will be no formal presentation.

The project is currently out to bid with contractors, and the Town Council will receive bids June 3 rd . A timeframe for construction starting is not yet known. However, at this time, the contract has deadlines of significant completion by the end of August and Final Payment by the end of September. There will be times when access to certain cul-de-sacs will be limited during construction. The contractor will be required to ensure access at the end of the work day, and maintain access as much as possible throughout the work day. The significant portion of work is expected to take 4 weeks once started. The Town is dedicated to completing this project in a timely matter and appreciates your patience during this time. To that effect, a Town representative will be on site during construction hours monitoring construction. A map of the affected area and new traffic pattern is enclosed with this letter. A larger map will be available for viewing at the open house.
