**Discussion:**


**Wastewater/Banning Presentation**

Wastewater Superintendent Jerry Crisp gave the council a brief history of the development of the wastewater system from 1914 onward before introducing Kent Elliot of Banning Engineering to give a longer presentation on the current state of the wastewater/sewage system, particularly the collection system. Kent also gave the council a detailed explanation of what all needs updated and replaced to bring the collection system up to date and gave the council an idea of how much time and money would be necessary. He also spoke about what would be necessary in building a new treatment facility. Jerry answered a few questions from the council regarding how to pay for the projects.

Buzz Krohn of O.W. Krohn Associates gave a detailed presentation to the council regarding the rate structure for public utilities as well as how to make sure that the utilities can pay for themselves given the future development that the town is expecting.
