



**Danville Town Council Work Study Minutes**  
**February 10, 2021**

- I. **Call to Order:** Council President Tom Pado called the work study meeting of the Danville Town Council to order on February 10, 2021.
- II. **Pledge of Allegiance:** Town Council President Tom Pado lead the council and those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- III. **Roll Call:** Town Council President Tom Pado acknowledged a quorum of the Council. Tom Pado, Nancy Leavitt, David Winters, Chris Gearld were present in the Town Hall while Greg VanLaere joined by phone. Town Manager Mark Morgan was present and Clerk-Treasurer Jenny Pearcy joined by phone.
- IV. **Topics of Discussion:**
  - a) **Host Fund Budget**—The council continued the discussion it had begun in the last work study session regarding the Host Fund Budget, mainly discussing details about particular items.
  - b) **Extension of COVID-19 Benefits**—Clerk-Treasurer Jenny Pearcy asked the council to consider extending COVID-19 benefits such that employees that have had to quarantine since December 31, 2020 would not have to use sick, vacation, or other forms of time off to avoid losing pay for the time that they had to take off. An amendment would have to be made because December 31 was when that benefit expired. Council President Tom Pado expressed a desire that such an amendment be made.
  - c) **Proposal for New Town Flag**—This item was moved.
  - d) **Discussion of Wastewater Easement Projects**—Wastewater Superintendent Jerry Crisp came forward to discuss various easements that the Wastewater Department is going to be using in the near future.
- V. **Adjournment:** David Winters motioned to adjourn the meeting and Chris Gearld seconded. Motion passed 5-0.
